In his opening remark, the chairman of the institute thanked the NSE President for receiving the institute. He highlighted the achievements of the institute in the recent past; the liaisons with NEPZA (Nigerian Export Processing Zones Authority), the workshop with BPP (Bureau Of Public Procurement), the outreach to the Director General of Raw Materials and the recently
